He has also served as a Deputy Attorney General with the Office of the Indiana Attorney General where he acted as litigation counsel representing various state agencies, including Department of Health, Department of Correction, Family and Social Services Administration, and Department of Child Services, in a variety of civil litigation matters.

Mr. Branich has been involved in cases dealing with breach of contract, fraud, constructive fraud, conversion, wage and compensation claims, antitrust, RICO, misappropriation of trade secrets, employment law and discrimination issues, covenants not to compete, negligence, products liability, shareholder disputes, commercial evictions, defamation, and creditors' rights. His practice has included cases in federal and state courts, both trial and appellate, ranging from the Seventh Circuit Court of Appeals down to small claims trials. Additionally, Mr. Branich has experience handling complex electronic discovery issues, collection matters, mental health commitments and administrative matters.
