PRIVACY NOTICE – MARKETING COMMUNICATIONS

This privacy notice tells you about the information we collect from you when you sign up to receive information via our website. What personal data do we collect?

Why do we collect this information?

What do we do with your information?

In order to protect your personal data from loss, or unauthorized use, access or disclosure, we utilize reasonable and appropriate physical, technical, and administrative procedures to safeguard the information we

collect and process. We will not share your information with third parties. If you do not consent to continue to receive future communications, your information that we presently hold will be stored in our database. We will not use the information to make any automated decisions that might affect you.

How long do we keep your information?

If you have given consent, we will continue to use your information to send you further communications until you unsubscribe. We may keep your information in our database unless you ask us to erase it. In any event, we will not use that information to send marketing communications to EU residents in the absence of consent or another accepted legal basis. Your rights over your information:
