Deborah Daniels was U.S. attorney for the Southern District of Indiana from 1988 to 1993 and also served as U.S. assistant attorney general from 2001-2005. Her work with the U.S. Department of Justice included the nation's response to the Sept. 11 terrorist attacks. Now, she's of counsel for Krieg DeVault LLP, where she worked from 1996 to 2001 and again since 2005. She served as the firm's managing partner from 2015-2018. She co-founded Coburn Place Safe Haven in 1995, was president of the Sagamore Institute from 2006-2008 and currently serves on several not-for-profit boards.
